

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Royal Albert Hall

The Royal Albert Hall is one of the UK's most loved and distinctive buildings, recognisable all over the world. The venue hosts more than 350 performances a year from international artists and shows including the BBC Proms each summer. The Royal Albert Hall also offers a number of guided tours for visitors.

Natural History Museum

The Natural History Museum is one of London's architectural treasures, filled with wonders from the natural world.

Science Museum

The Science Museum covers all areas of science and technology and exhibits world-class collections of scientific, technological and medical achievements from across the globe.

Victoria and Albert Museum

The V&A is a haven for fans of art and design. It houses a permanent collection of over 2.3 million objects from architecture, furniture, fashion, photography, ceramics and much more.

Hyde Park and Marble Arch

Hyde Park is just a few minutes' walk from Beit Hall and offers 350 acres of green open space in the heart of central London. It's one of eight Royal Parks in the Capital and is home to the Serpentine Lake, Speakers' Corner, Diana Princess of Wales Memorial Fountain and the Serpentine Lido.

Shopping

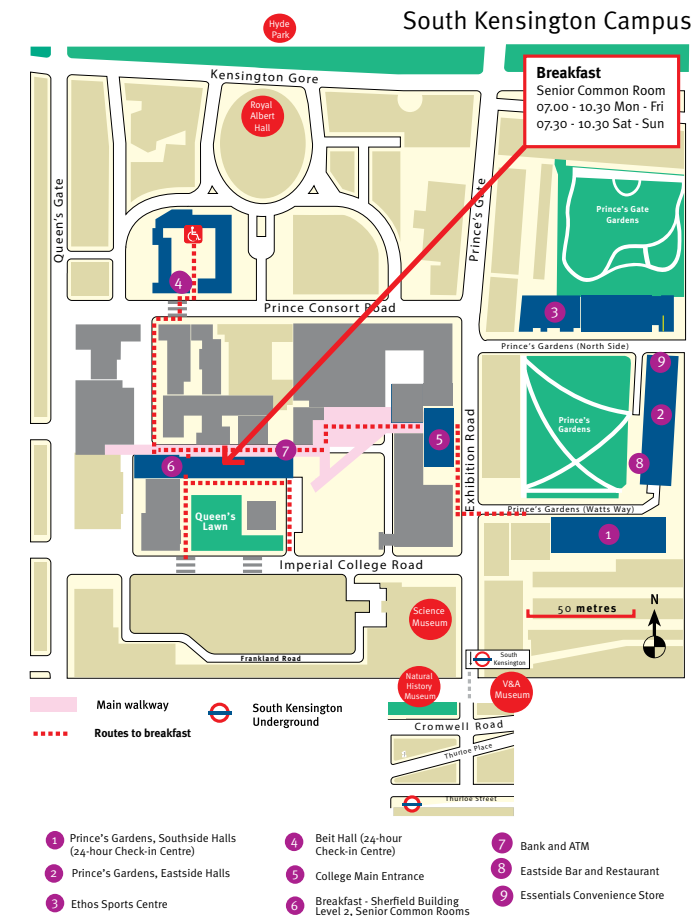
For all your shopping needs, head down the road to Knightsbridge, home to Harrods and Harvey Nichols. For a wider variety of stores, Oxford Street is just a short bus journey away.

Transport

South Kensington and Gloucester Road underground stations are a 10-minute walk away and are served by the **Piccadilly, Circle and District lines**.

The number **360** bus stops outside Beit Hall. London buses operate on a cashless system. A single bus journey costs £1.50 and you can pay with a contactless debit/credit card or contactless Oyster card.

Check in and Check out

Housekeeping and Laundry

Rooms are cleaned daily and linen changed every three days. The laundry room is located on the basement floor of the west wing. All machines operate using a mobile app which can be downloaded to your iPhone or Android phone. Details can be found in the laundry room. If you don't have a smartphone, please ask at reception for information on alternatives.

Internet Access

Cabled internet access is available in all bedrooms. Free Sky Cloud WiFi is available throughout Beit Hall.

Items Available from Reception

A number of items are available from reception including travel adaptors, fans, internet cables and additional pillows, linen and towels. All items are subject to availability; additional charges may apply.

Consumables

Toiletries, tea and coffee are provided on arrival and replenished every three days. Bottled water is provided on arrival; a water fountain is available next to reception.

Under 18s policy

Due to licensing laws, anyone under the age of 18 is not permitted in Beit Hall, the Bar or courtyard area.

England operates a smoke-free law and it is illegal to smoke in any of our buildings. Imperial is a smoke-free campus and guests will not be permitted to smoke within 20-metres of Beit Hall.
